

28th Annual Holiday Printmakers' Sale and Exhibition Dec. 7, 2012

to benefit the Printmaking Area & Students, Center for the Visual Arts, Illinois State University

This year's print sale and exhibition will be held in the **Lithography Studio, CVA Room 127** on Friday, December 7, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. We encourage all Illinois State University Printmaking students, faculty and staff to participate in the exhibition and sale.

SPECIAL EVENT: A preview for members of the Friends of the Arts organization will be held on Thursday, December 6th from **5:00 to 7:00 PM**.

Artwork will be accepted for the sale in CVA 129 on Wednesday, Dec. 5th from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. and Thursday, Dec. 6th from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00. Please respect the classes in session on these days. Preparation of finished prints and paperwork should be accomplished outside of classes. The Artist's Agreement form must be completed and submitted with your artwork in order for it to be accepted. Please fill in your **university ID number**, name, address, and zip-code on the Artist's Agreement form. Checks from the proceeds will be written by the University after the sale. **Please use the mailing address where you would like to receive any payment due to you as a result of the sale with consideration that the checks will be sent out during break.** Twenty percent (20%) of all sales will be used to support the Illinois State University Printmaking Program. This donation will be deducted from the prices listed on the Artist's Agreement form.

Wrapping prints in acetate, clear cellophane, or shrink-wrap is not required, but is the best assurance that they will not suffer from handling by the public. Framed works are accepted, however, framing is not necessary. Each item should be marked clearly with the artist's name, title, price, and corresponding number from the consignment list, this information may be attached to the work with a paperclip. Make sure the tags are secure; any price confusion resulting from price tags that have fallen off will be the responsibility of the artist. When starting a new page please use continuous numbers. Here is an example of a good tag:

The print sale needs volunteers to function, and patrons often like to meet the artist of work they picked, so volunteering can be a way to make future connections. You may include an artist's statement and/or biography (less than a page) with your forms. Unsold work may be picked up at the close of the sale **Friday, Dec. 7th at 5:00 p.m. and Monday, Dec. 10th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon in CVA 129**. Please make an appointment if another time is necessary (438-7530). Unsold work not picked up by Thursday, Dec. 13th will be disposed of at the discretion of the printmaking area.

Reasonable care will be given in the handling of the work during the sale. However, the printmaking area does not provide insurance against nor assume responsibility for loss or damage to submitted work. By participating in this sale and exhibition, the artist accepts the terms of the agreement.

Participant's Check List:

1. Price all items and attach tags to work. If desired, wrap each item in acetate, clear cellophane, or shrink-wrap to protect prints from handling.
2. Fill out the Artist's Agreement consignment form, listing **each item on a separate line**. Multiple works of the same title **must** include impression numbers and designate each print on a separate line. **Remember to include the print's number from the consignment form on the tag.**
3. Fill out name and address information section to receive payment from the sale—checks should be sent out during break—use the address where you wish to receive payment at that time.
4. Submit artwork: **CVA room 129 (Lithography), on Wednesday, Dec. 5th from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. and Thursday, Dec. 6th from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon**. A short statement/bio **optional**.
5. Attend Print Sale & Exhibition and volunteer some time.
6. Pick-up unsold artwork: **Friday, December 7th at 5:00 p.m. or Monday, December 10th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon in CVA Room 129**.
